Paid parking is in effect from December 1, 2025 to April 30, 2026.  
Free parking is granted for the first hour every day.

## Parking accessibility

### Passerelle Parking:

Free for buses, payment via on-site parking meter for motorhomes.

### Glaciers Parking:

Purchase at the on-site kiosk, no reservation option available.

### Alpe de Venosc (Covered) Parking:

Purchase at the on-site kiosk.

## CAMPER VAN PARKING RATES

The parking area is subject to charges from January 1 to December 31, with a limited stay of 2 consecutive weeks. No reservations are possible. There are 20 spaces available during the winter season and 60 spaces during the summer season.

# General Information

## For individual residents:

- ▶ A subscription permits parking in the residential zone, with preferential rates.
- ▶ Alternatively, in one of the two peripheral zones of choice, if residing within the municipal area but outside of paid parking zones.

## For professionals and residents and non-resident employees:

- ▶ A subscription to park in their professional activity zone.
- ▶ Residents must choose between their residential or work zone, with no option to combine multiple zones.

## For mobile professionals, both resident and non-resident:

- ▶ A subscription for all zones if their activity requires frequent travel throughout the municipality.

- ▶ The eligible APE/NAF codes can be consulted on the city hall website.

## CONDITIONS FOR FREE PARKING

- ▶ Once per day, for 30 minutes on any parking spot (1 hour on Saturdays).
- ▶ On «arrêt minute» spaces (quick stops allowed up to 30 minutes).
- ▶ In villages and hamlets.
- ▶ Everywhere for individuals holding a CMI card (disabled parking badge), as well as in accessible parking spaces for people with reduced mobility (PMR).
- ▶ For vehicles used for public service, security, rescue, or emergency missions.
- ▶ For health and social care professionals when traveling for professional activities. The eligible APE/NAF codes can be consulted on the city hall website.

## Top tips

- ▶ The Parking des Glaciers car park offers a more advantageous weekly rate.
- ▶ You can park in the peripheral areas and reach the resort center using the free shuttle buses.

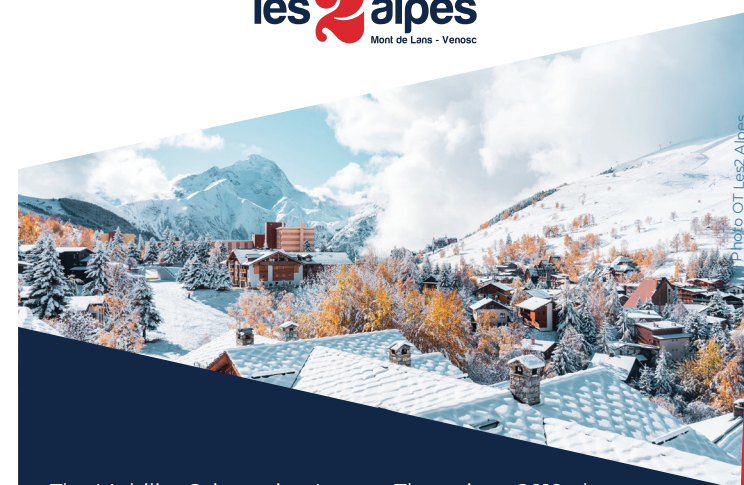

The Mobility Orientation Law (LOM), adopted in France in 2019, aims to fundamentally reform public policies related to transportation and mobility. It is based on four main key areas:

- ▶ Improvement of daily transportation with more accessible, efficient, and cost-effective solutions.
- ▶ Transition to more sustainable transport through soft mobility modes and the development of infrastructure to support these transport options.
- ▶ Governance and funding: the LOM gives more responsibilities to local authorities in managing mobility.
- ▶ Innovation: by facilitating the integration of digital solutions for mobility services.

Thus, since 2019, the regulatory framework for local authorities has evolved, and the new team has decided to make the issue a priority in order to make up for delays.

### Expectations and benefits of the project for the territory

- ▶ Regulatory compliance with the Mobility Orientation Law (e.g., development of cycling lanes).
- ▶ In line with ecological challenges, reduction in the number of cars on the station and their use for short trips.
- ▶ Improvement of the attractiveness of the resort centre, more suited to the development of soft mobility (shuttles, pedestrians, bicycles, etc.).
- ▶ A new source of revenue to fund the transition to soft mobility without increasing local taxes.
